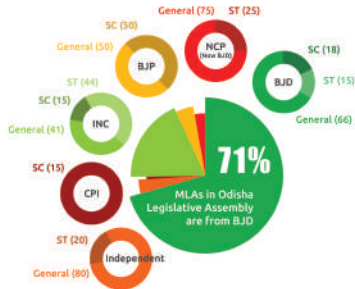

9.8% Jharkhand

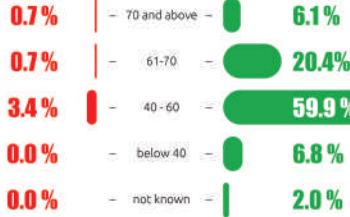
11.0% Chhattisgarh

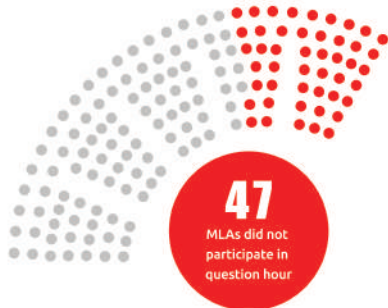

835 starred questions and 2488 unstarred questions were analysed

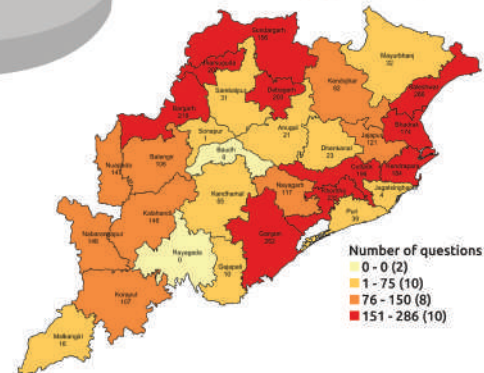
Starred Qs: Questions that are answered orally

Unstarred Qs: Questions that are answered in writing

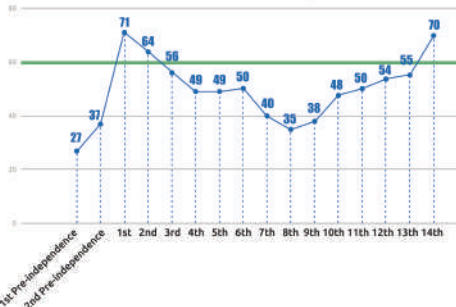
Any member can give notice for a maximum of 3 starred and 5 unstarred questions per day per sitting.



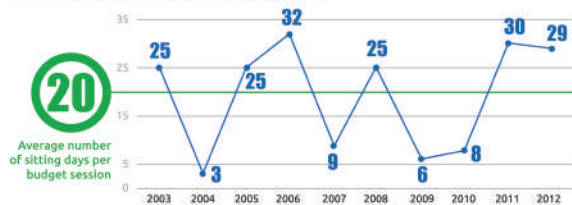
Maximum questions from Coastal and North-west Odisha; Boudh and Rayagada forgotten



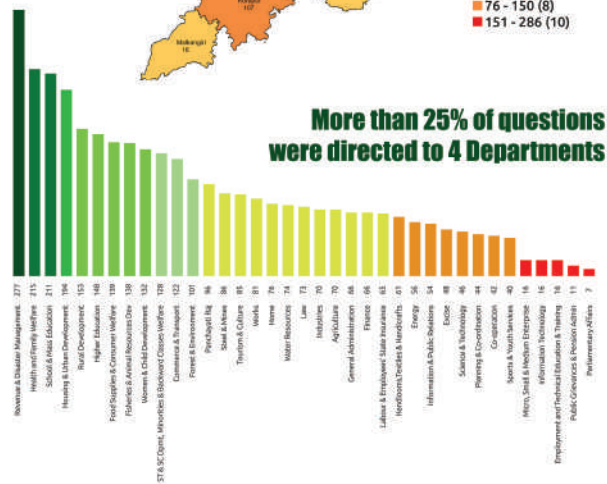
Only 3 assemblies exceeded the stipulated duration for assembly sittings
