

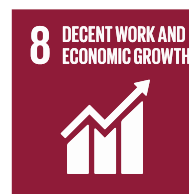

ISSUE

In course of more than three decades of its existence, CYSD has undergone massive changes from being a single project organization to presently reaching out to more than one million households across six districts. One of the fallouts of the rapid growth is the reduced efficacy of its management information system (MIS). In the absence of strong information system architecture, the MIS system had been 'individual' dependent, leading to loss of institutional knowledge base, non-standardised processes for data capture, and ad hoc mechanisms for information dissemination.

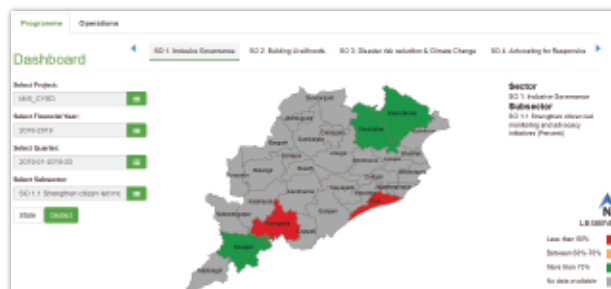
