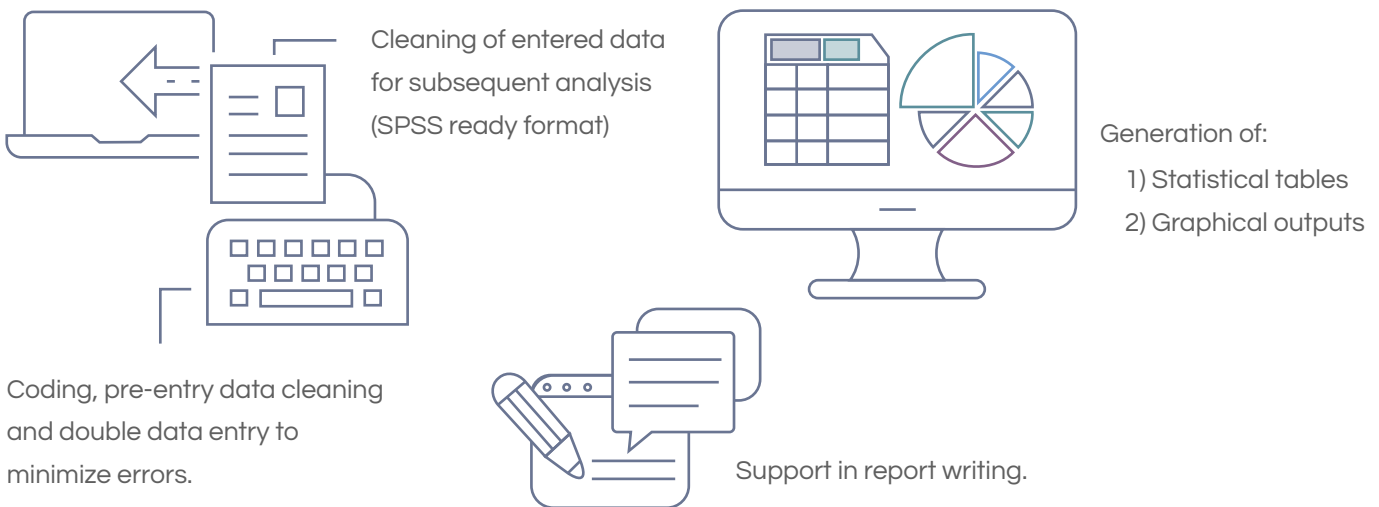

## ISSUE

The National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR) had conducted a study among school children in seven states (7000 respondents) with an aim to generate statistical evidence of school going children being subjected to corporal punishment in schools. Through the study findings dissemination, NCPCR aimed to create a discourse of awareness on traumatic effects of corporal punishment among parents, teachers and administrators.
