## ISSUE

The National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR), set up in 2007, has a mandate is to ensure that all Laws, Policies, Programmes, and Administrative Mechanisms are in consonance with the Child Rights. NCPCR needed to know the implementation status of The Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children) Act, 2000 in all the states of the country.

## INTERVENTION

SDRC supported the NCPCR with analysis of the responses received from the States/UTs on the reporting format on the implementation status of the JJ Act. Besides a report based on the analysis presenting a macro picture, the output of the assignment included a power point presentation on the same and factsheets for each state and union territory. The key components covered in the factsheet depicted the achievements w.r.t institutional arrangements for children in conflict with law, children in need of care and protection as well as mechanisms for rehabilitation of children with special needs.
