ISSUE

Over 95% of electronic items are sold to scrap dealers and eventually are disposed using environmentally unsound practices

The formal infrastructure in cities to channelize the e-waste for sound recycling is underdeveloped

Lack of awareness among consumers and bulk consumers contributes to the mishandling of e-waste, causing damage to the environment and human health

INTERVENTION

Established an effective e-waste collection system in the city that ensures proper channelization.

Generated awareness among consumers, households, schools, colleges and other institutions regarding menace of e-waste and effective handling to curb the impact

Developed a sustainable e-waste ecosystem in the city that integrates the informal sector, and creates appropriate linkages with formal collection centres, repair shops, dealers, bulk consumers, dismantlers, recyclers and other members of the e-waste supply chain leading to a business value proposition in local recycling and processing of e-waste.
