ISSUE

Curbing diarrhoea and pneumonia among children requires enhanced institutional capacity and preparedness in improving access, coverage and utilization of drugs like vitamin A, zinc, ORS, strong referral linkages. These can be achieved through strategized interventions like capacity building of key stakeholders, mobilization of community level institutions, knowledge management and integrated campaigns. Designing these interventions require information on current status of service provider's knowledge level, compliance to standard operating procedures, information flow channels.

INTERVENTION



Data collectors trained on survey questionnaires, data collection using data entry application.



Provision of using handheld devices for data collection from field level respondents.



Provision of capturing geo coordinate, incorporation of skip patterns to ensure quality of data collected.



Data collated and analyzed to understand the demographic and socio economic profile of community, knowledge level of front line workers.
