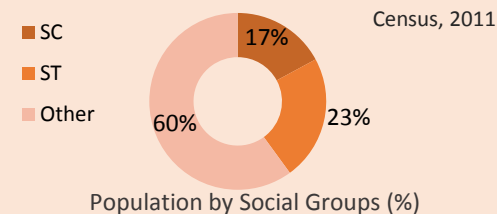

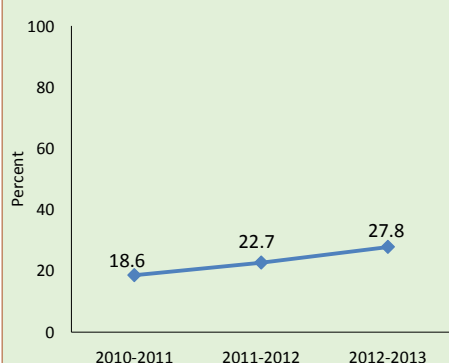

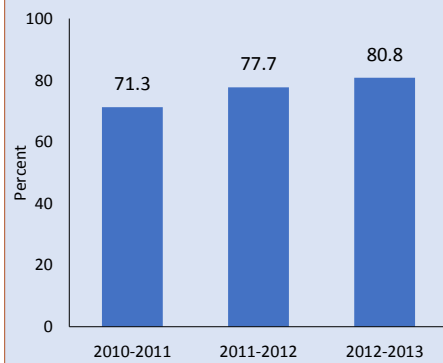
### Full Antenatal Checkup (ANC)

Percentage of women who had at least 3 visits for ANC, one TT injection and IFA consumption for 100 days or more



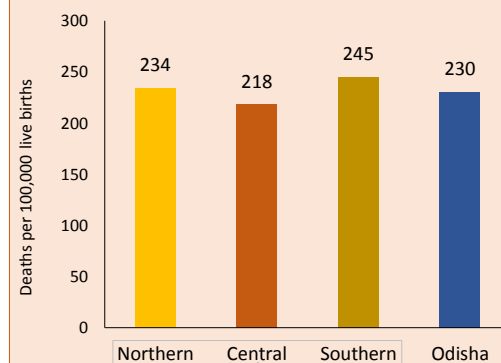
### Institutional deliveries

### Maternal mortality ratio

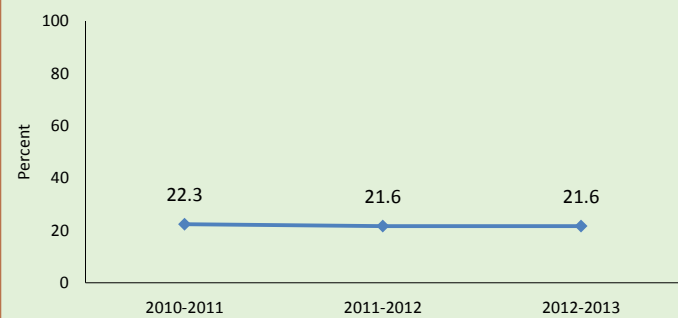
Number of maternal deaths per 100,000 live births

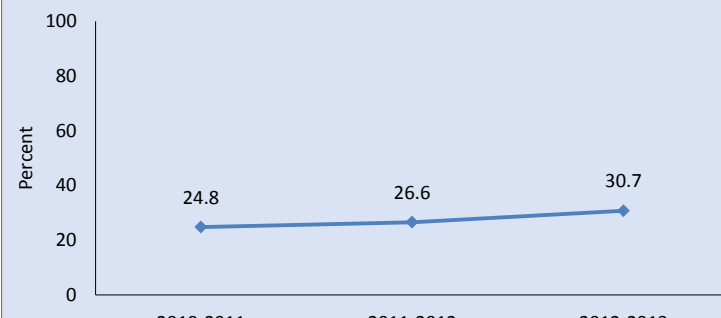
### Low birthweight

### Exclusive breastfeeding

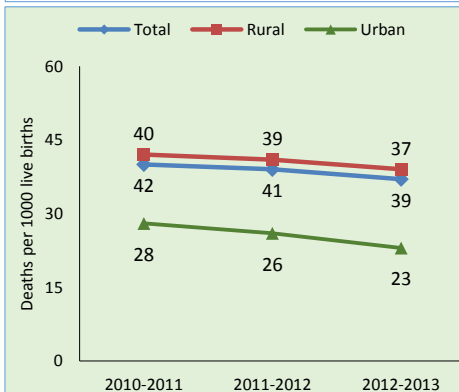

## Neo-natal mortality rate

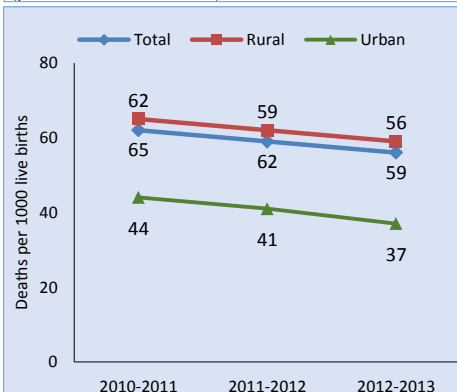
The number of new born deaths within 28 days of birth (per thousand live births)

## Infant mortality rate

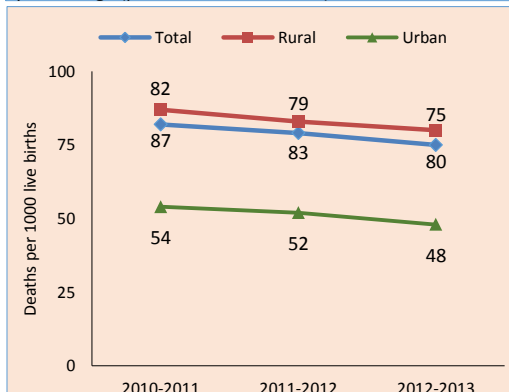
The number of infant deaths within one year of birth (per thousand live births)

Number of children dying before completing five years of age (per thousand live births)

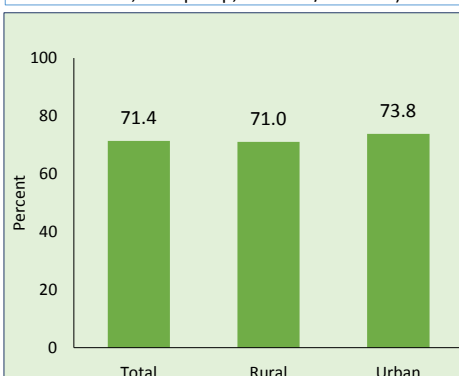

## Drinking water

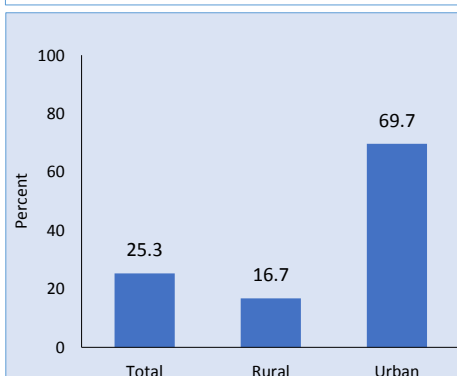
Households using safe drinking water (tap water from treated source, handpump, tubewell/borewell)

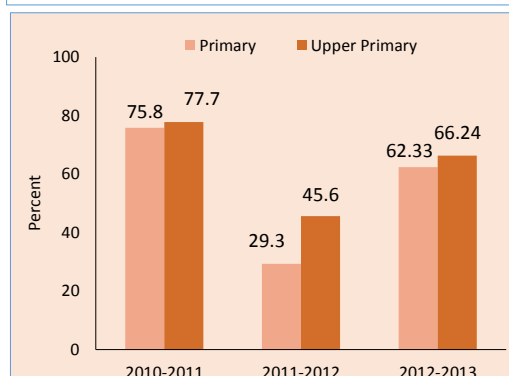
Households having latrine facility within premises

Percentage of schools with separate girls toilets

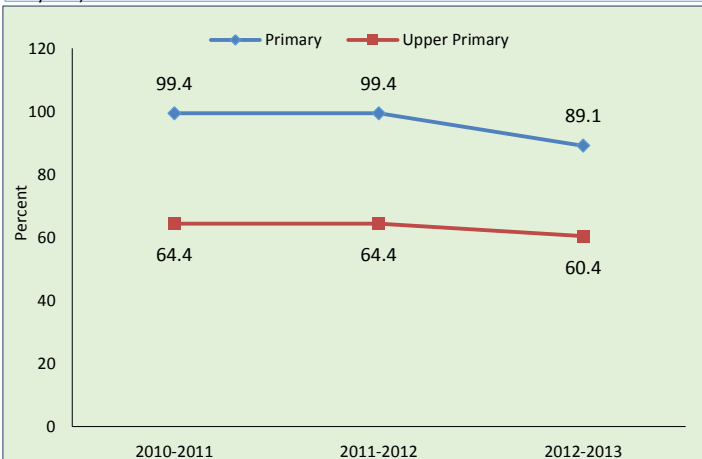

## Net enrolment ratio

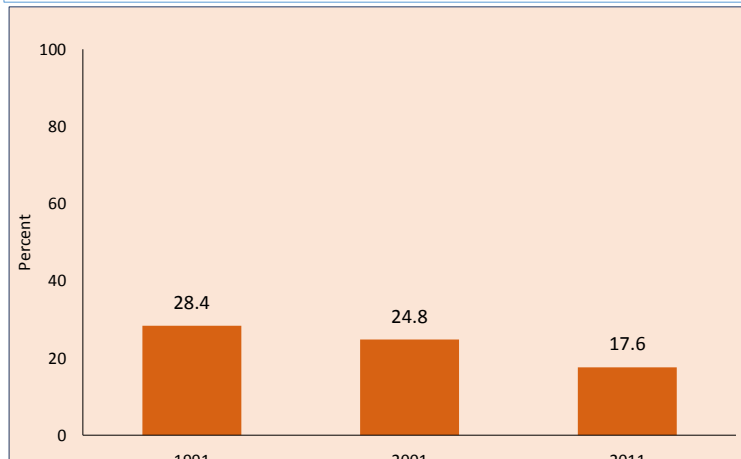
Enrolment in primary education (Grades I-V) of the primary school age group (6 to 10 years)

The absolute difference between literacy rate (7+ yrs) of males and females



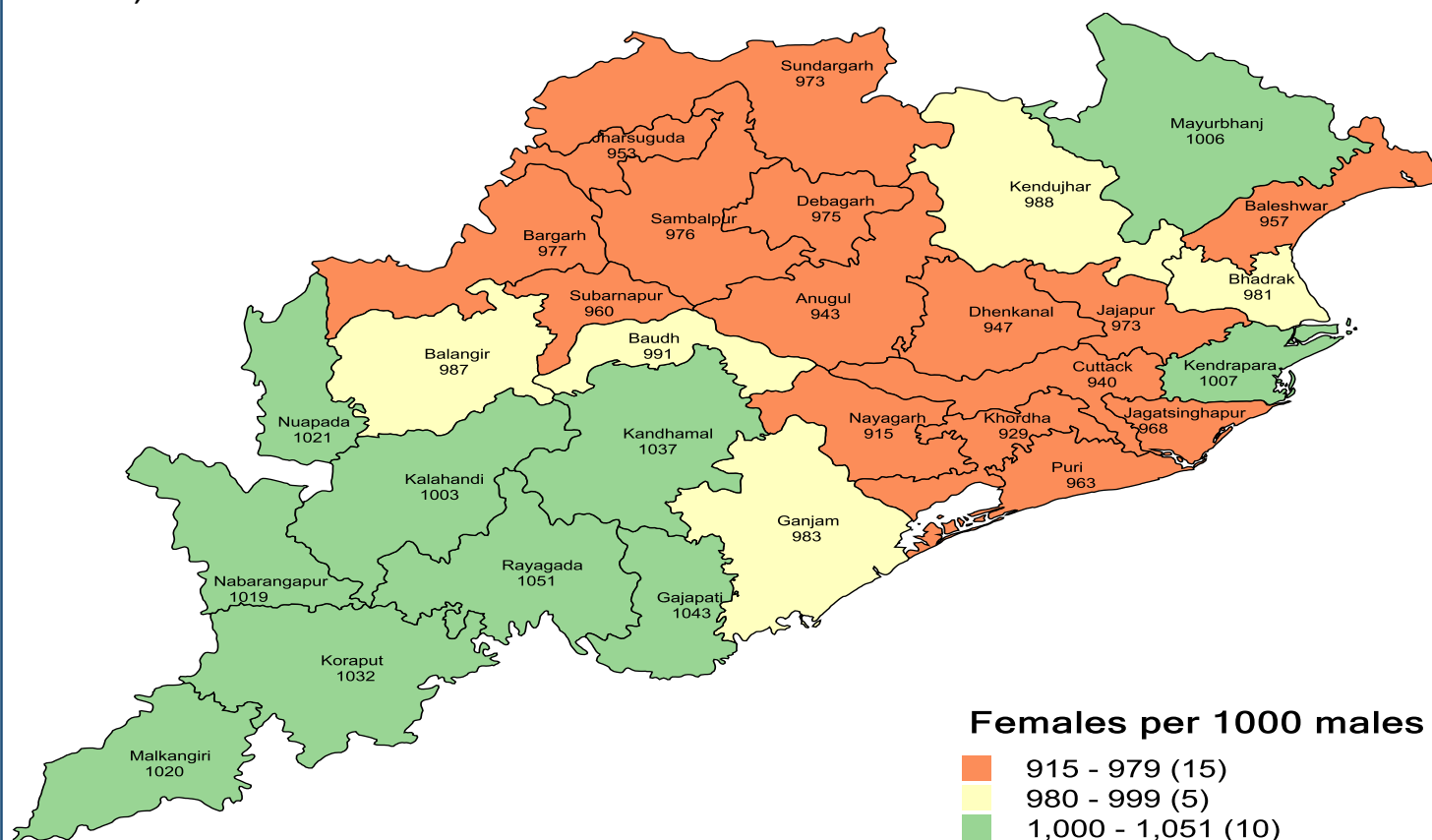

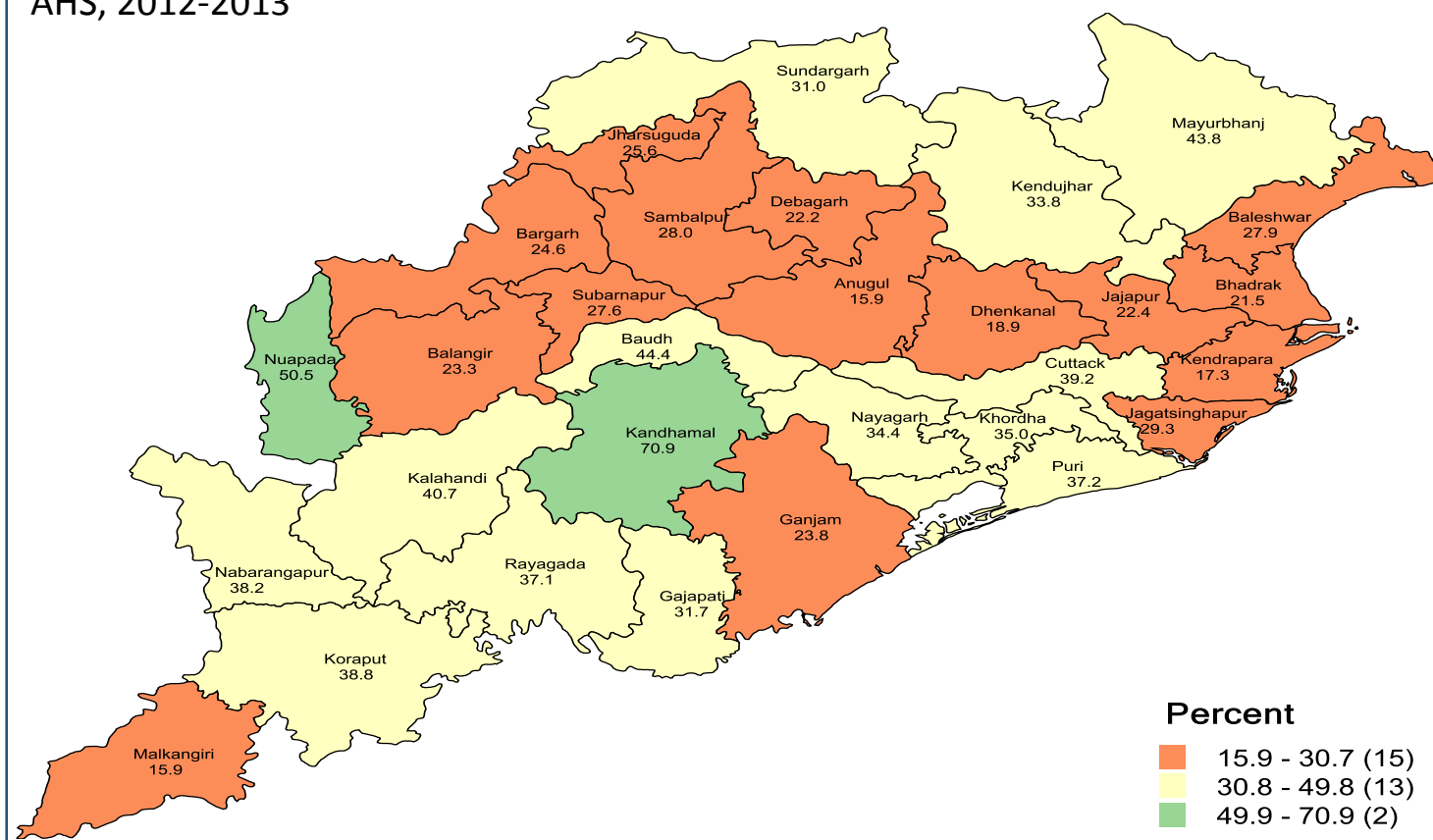
## Sex Ratio (Females per 1000 males)

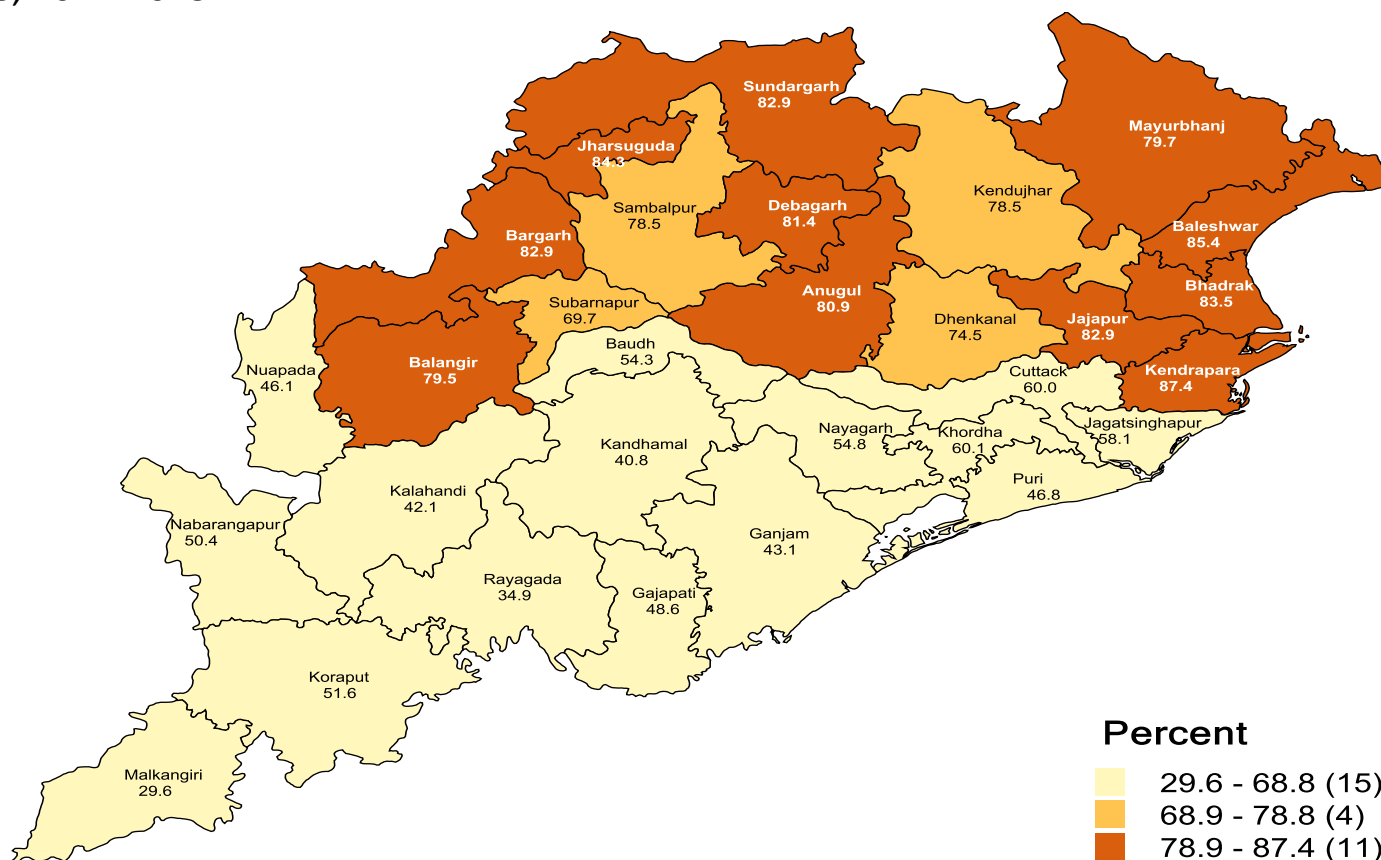
## Children aged 6-35 months exclusively breastfed for at least six months (percent),

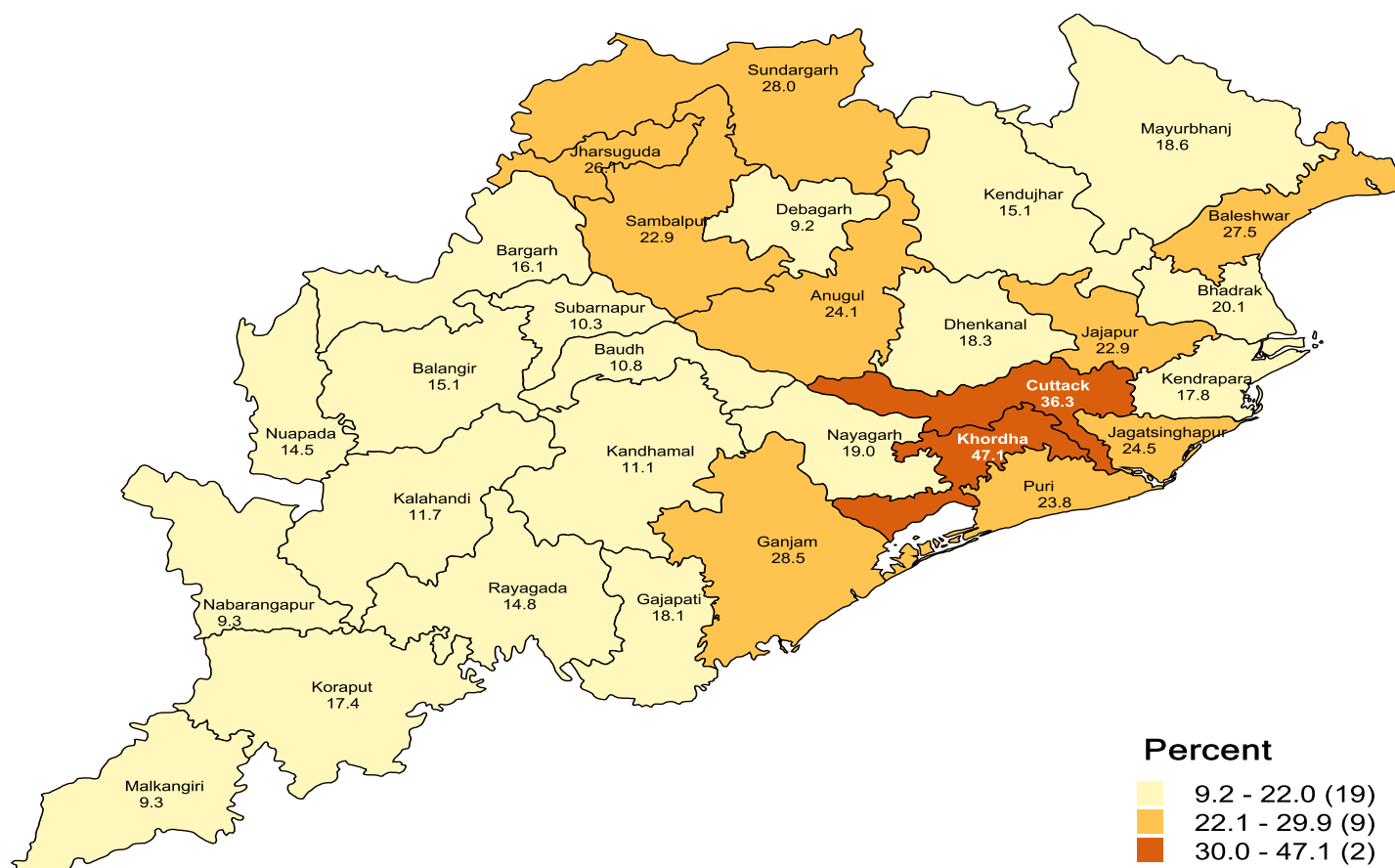
## Children aged 12-23 months fully immunized (percent)

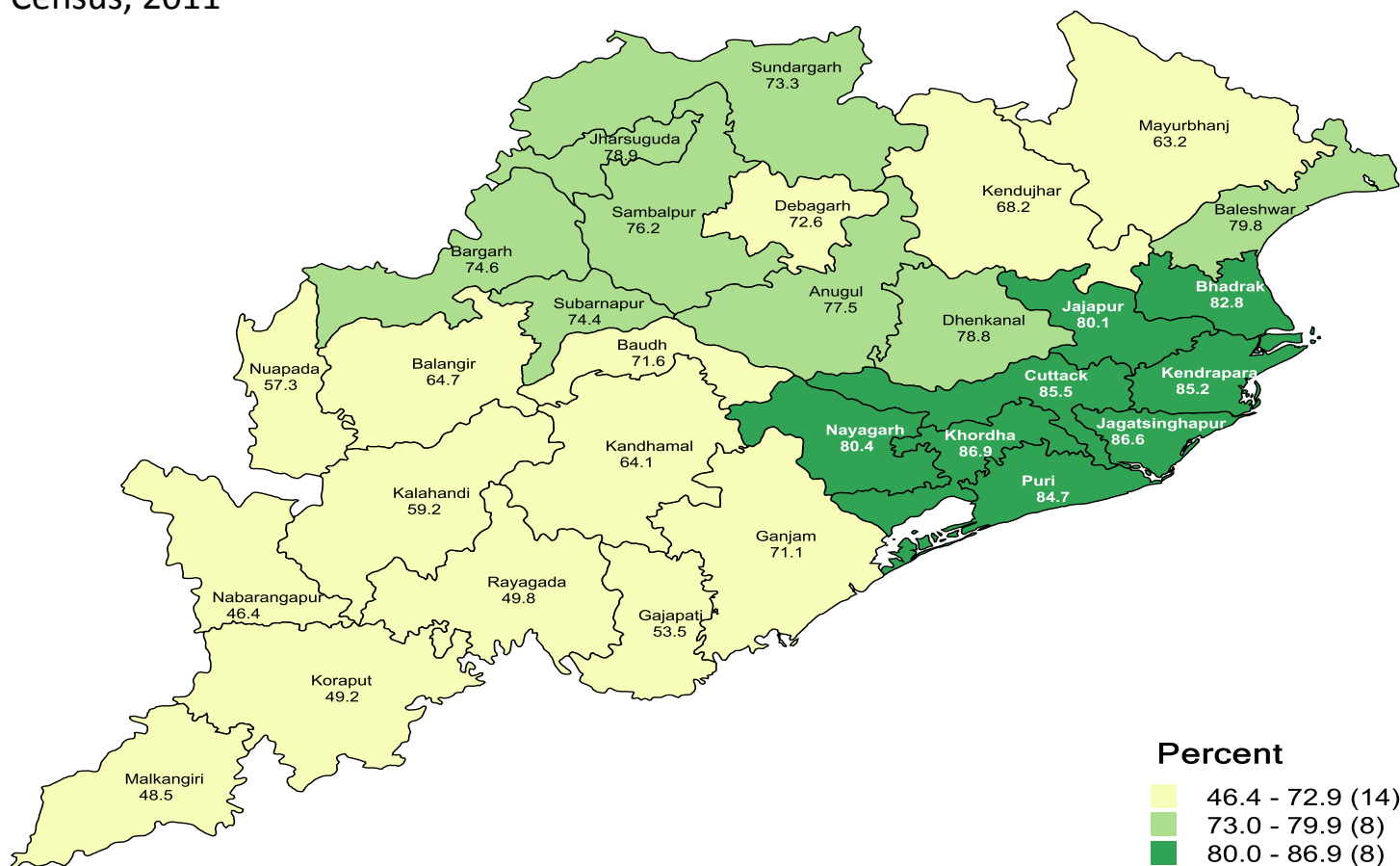
## Households having latrine facility within premises (Percent)
