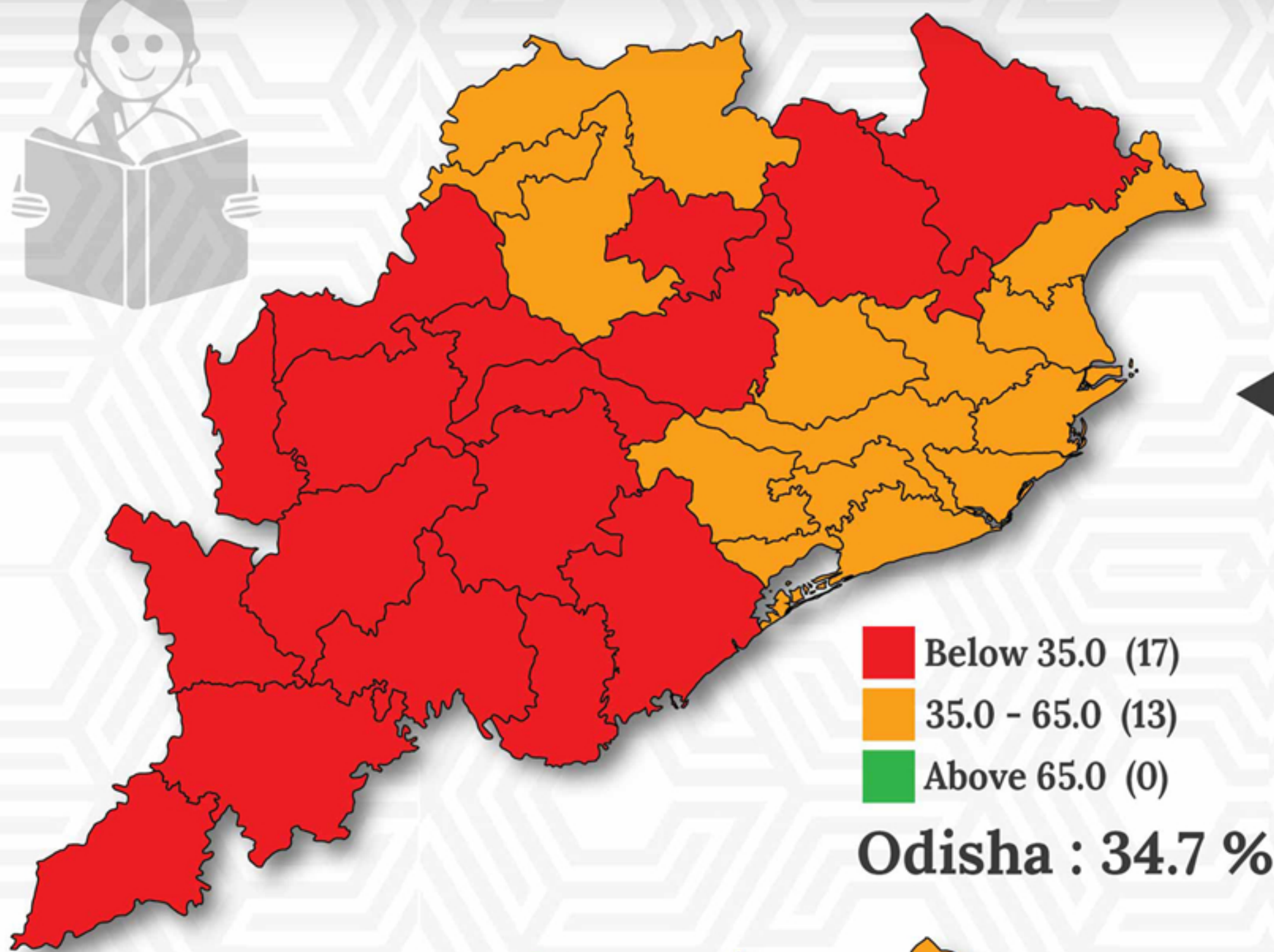
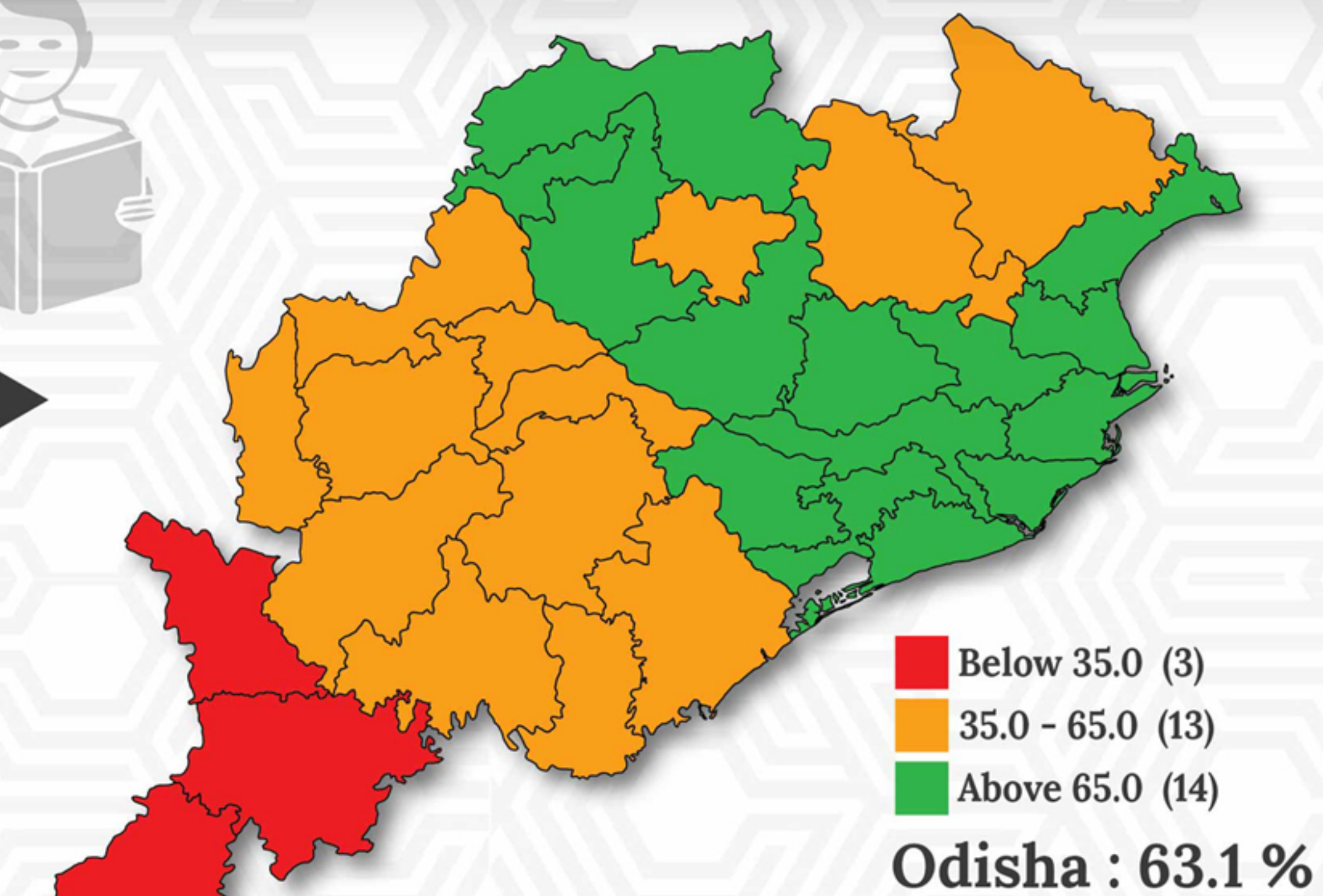


What is the status of literacy rate among women in Odisha?

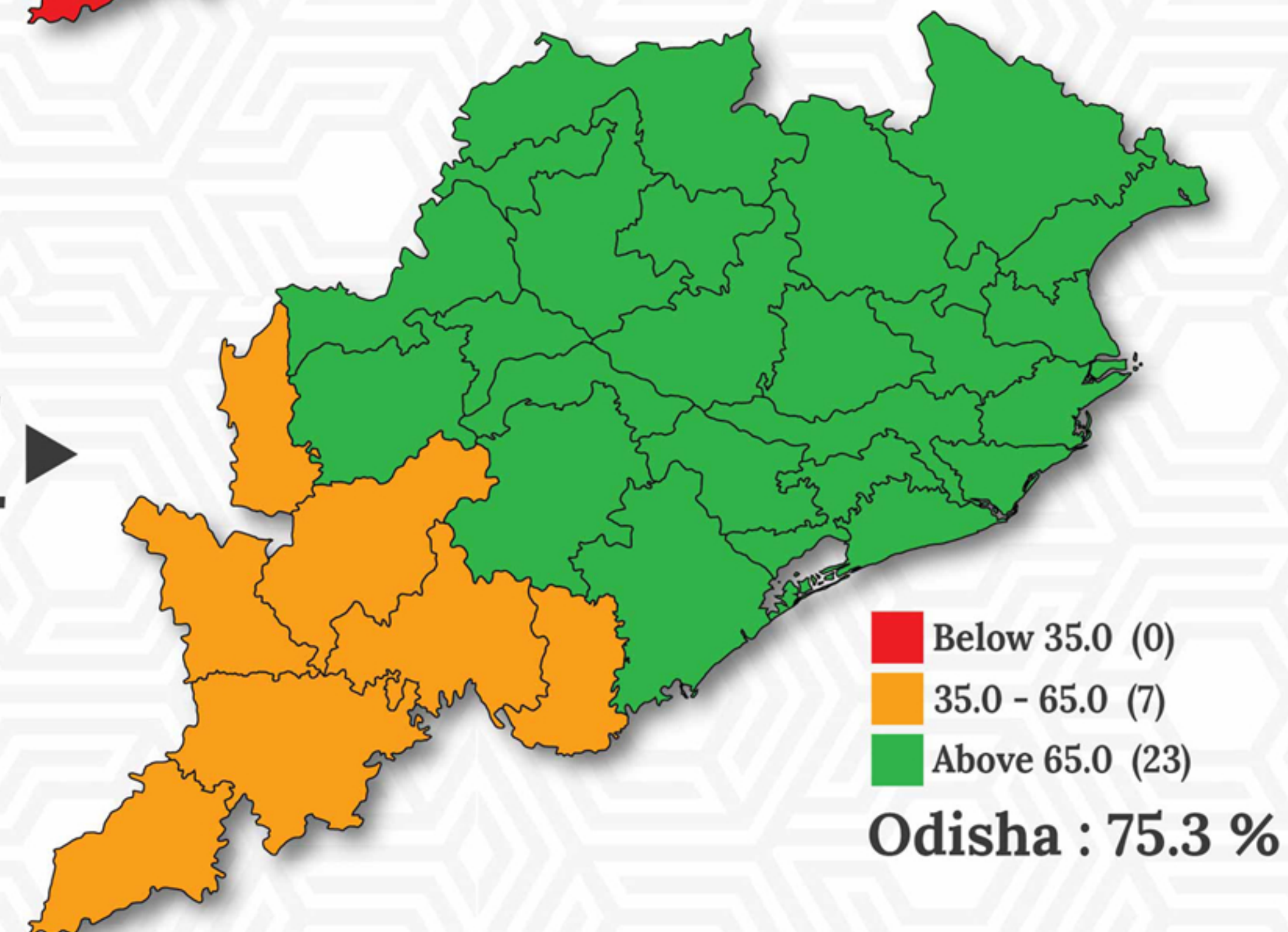
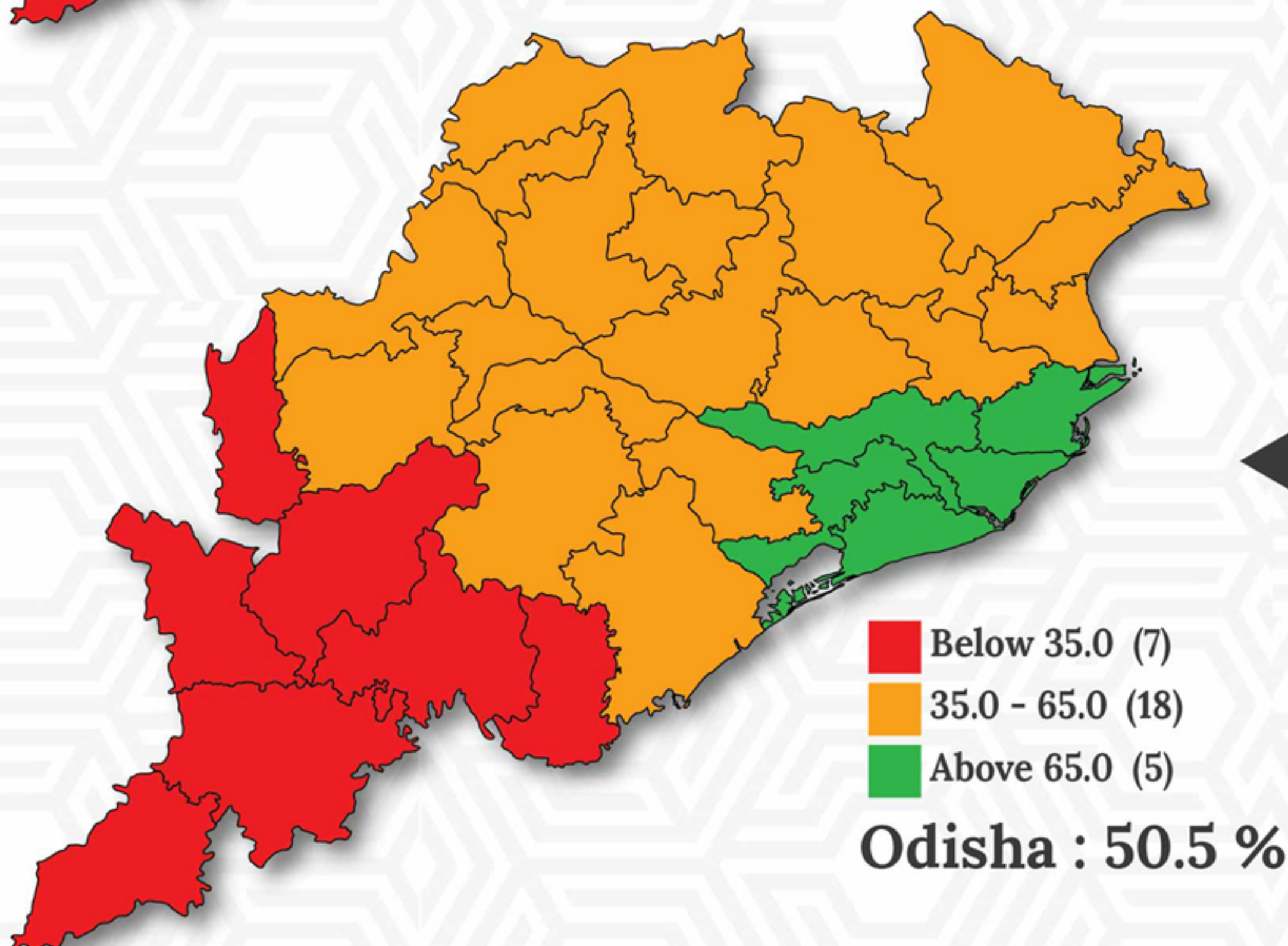
Female literacy (7+ years)



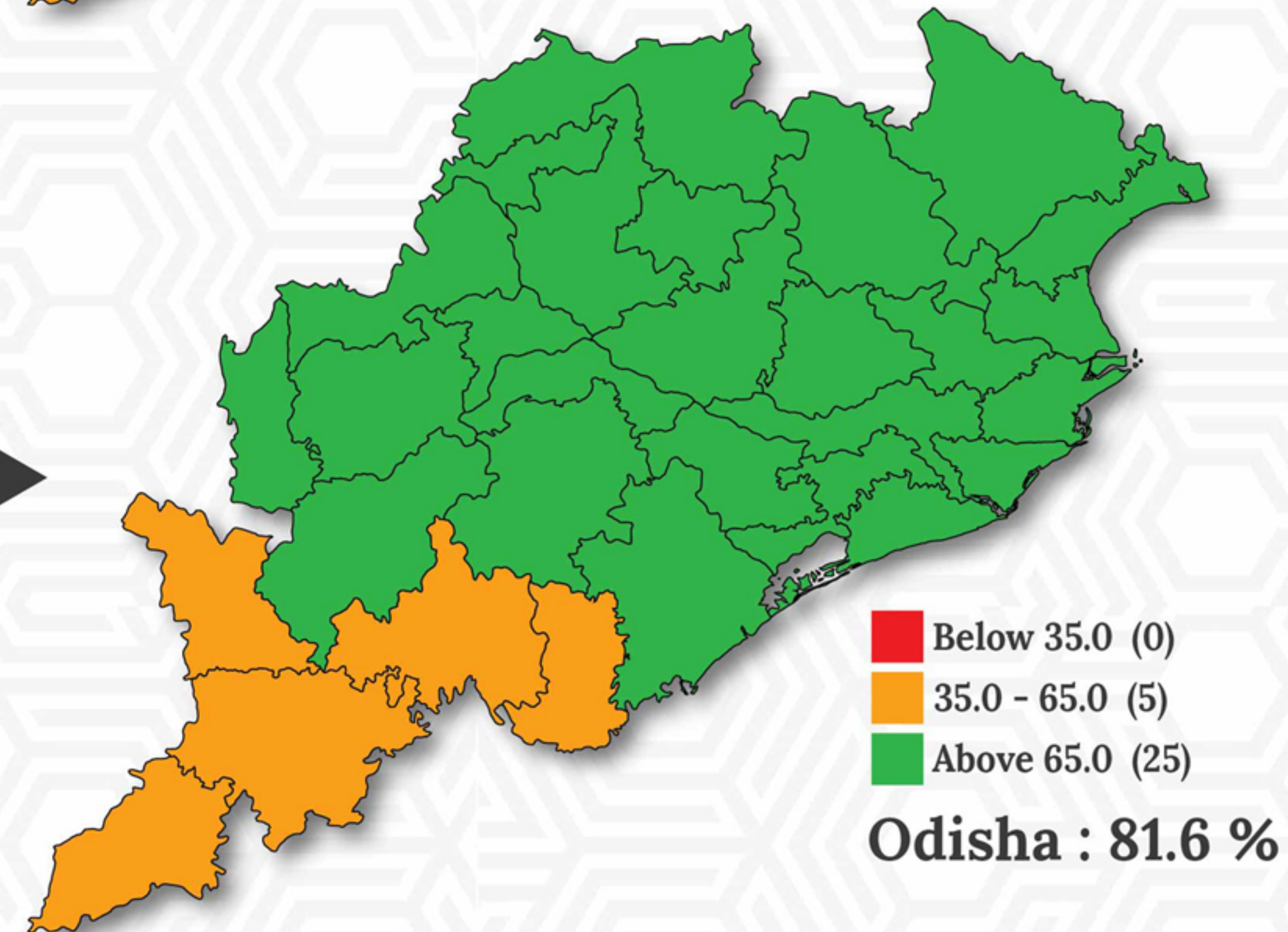
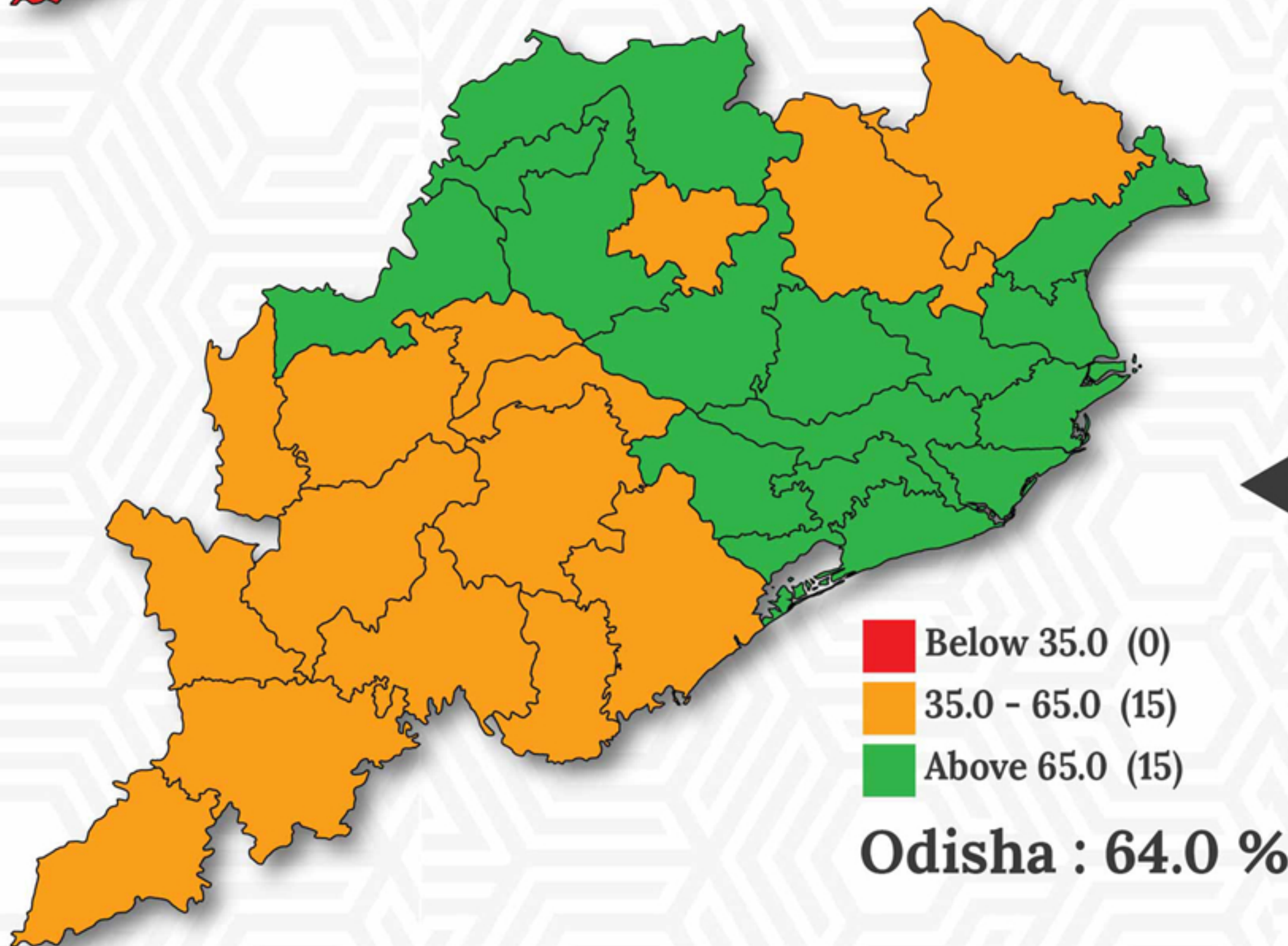
Male literacy (7+ years)

KEY TAKEAWAYS:

► While all districts have improved in overall literacy between **1991** and **2011**, female literacy rate is still much lower than the male literacy rate.

As per 2011 census data:

► While **25** districts have male literacy rate of above **65.0%**, only **15** districts have the same rate of female literacy rate.

► Five districts in Odisha reported over **90%** literate male population. While the highest rate of male literacy reported was **92.4%** in Jagatsinghpur district, the highest rate of female literacy rate was **81.6%** in Khorda.

► Nearly half of total districts are below the state's average female literacy rate.
