

People Living with HIV (PLHIV) in Odisha




- ▶ India had the third largest HIV cases in the world, with 2.1 million PLHIV.
- ▶ Odisha had the **14th highest** population of PLHIV in India in 2019.

# Adult HIV prevalence of Odisha increased marginally during 2017 to 2019.

Estimated Adult (15-49 years) HIV Prevalence




► Adult HIV prevalence of both India and Odisha were at the same rate in 2013, Odisha witnessed a sharp decline between 2015 and 2017 but it has again increased from 2017 to 2019.

#### 2170 new HIV infections were reported in Odisha in 2019.

No. of annual new HIV infections in Odisha




- ► Although the absolute number of new cases is showing decline in trend, the percentage share of new HIV infections from Odisha increased from 2.8% in 2017 to 3.1% in 2019.
- ► Odisha reported **15th highest** number of new infections among 35 sates and UTs in 2019.

Comprehensive knowledge of HIV/AIDS in Odisha




▶ One in five females in Odisha (slightly less than national average, 20.9%) and one in three males had comprehensive knowledge about HIV/AIDS.

AIDS related deaths in Odisha




- ▶ 10th highest number of annual AIDS related deaths were reported in Odisha in 2019.
- ▶ The percentage share of deaths reported from Odisha rose from 2% in 2017 to 3% in 2019.
